

Youth Contract 2022

Must be read & signed by all Wolf Cubs, Benjamites, Teens.

*One of the goals of Camp Mashiach is to provide a fun and safe environment for Messianic youth to congregate and leave the secular world behind. **This includes all politics, conspiracy theories, and topics of great controversy.** It is for this reason that we have some rules that must be followed to ensure everyone at Camp Mashiach will have a fun and blessed time. The following rules will be discussed in detail on the first day of camp.*



PROHIBITED POSSESSIONS:

- Tobacco in any form
- Alcohol
- Drugs
- Weapons of any kind
- Any explosive devices [fireworks]
- Any item with direct ties to the occult [Magic: the Gathering cards, jewelry, etc...]

PROHIBITED ACTIONS:

- Blatant disregard for rules & authority
- Physical altercations [fighting, pushing, shoving, etc...]
- Stealing
- Trespassing another's property
- Moving your bunk or taking your name tag off your bunk.
- Sleeping in the same bed with another camper or staff member.
- Sexual contact with another camper
- Sexual contact with a staff member

The possession or action of any of the above items will result in disciplinary action, up to and including immediate dismissal from Camp Mashiach without refund, removal from the premises of WNC Gateway Campground & Conference Center, and/or a ban from subsequent Camp Mashiach events at the discretion of the Camp Director. and Camp Leadership Team.

The use of foul language will not be tolerated in any form or fashion. It will be the judgment of an adult staff member to determine what is inappropriate. Fighting or activity that has the intention of causing harm to another person will not be tolerated.

Modesty will prevail in all clothing matters. Likewise, any questionable slogans, graphics, or any political statements on clothing will not be allowed. It will be the judgment of an adult staff member to determine what is inappropriate. For your safety, **closed-toed shoes** are to be worn at all times. During co-ed swim activities, gals are to wear a dark t-shirt & shorts over all bathing suits, and guys are to wear a t-shirt or tank top with swim trunks.

You will not be allowed to leave the camp facilities for any reason without the approval of the Camp Security. You must also comply with further guidelines that will be announced on the first day of camp.

Your Statement:

I understand and agree to obey the rules of the camp and conduct myself in a manner that is moral and upright before the Lord. I will follow the camp schedule and participate in **all** camp activities to the best of my ability. I will respect all "off-limit" areas and each nightly curfew. I will not be alone with any member of the opposite sex at any time during Camp Mashiach. I understand that the six days of Camp Mashiach are to be a departure from the secular world where I live. I will not say, wear, nor do anything that may offend any other person at Camp Mashiach. I will do my best to meet new friends and be a blessing to everyone at camp. Most of all, I will have fun and receive a blessing from Camp Mashiach!
