

CAMPER CONTRACT

MUST BE SIGNED BY ALL CAMPERS

One of our core goals at Camp Mashiach is to create a joyful, safe space where Messianic youth can gather, connect, and step away from the distractions of the secular world. To support this, we ask campers to refrain from engaging in politics, conspiracy theories, or other highly divisive topics. These guidelines help ensure that everyone can enjoy a peaceful, uplifting, and spiritually focused experience. We will review each of these rules together on the first day of camp

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

DO NOT BRING THESE TO CAMP

- Tobacco products or Vapes
- Alcohol
- illegal drugs
- Pornography of any kind, in any format.
- Weapons of any kind
- Knives/Multi-tools
- Explosive devices (including fireworks)
- Occult-related items
- A disrespectful or disruptive attitude

PROHIBITED ACTIONS:

DO NOT DO THESE THINGS AT CAMP

- Defying camp rules or leadership
- Any physical aggression [fighting, pushing, shoving, etc...]
- Stealing [taking anything that doesn't belong to you]
- Damaging personal or campground property.
- Defacing of Property
- Moving your assigned bunk or removing your bunk name tag
- Sharing a bed with any camper or staff member
- Sexual contact between campers
- Sexual contact between a camper and staff member

ANY PROHIBITED ITEM OR BEHAVIOR WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, INCLUDING IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL WITHOUT REFUND, REMOVAL FROM THE CAMPGROUND & CONFERENCE CENTER, AND/OR RESTRICTION FROM FUTURE CAMP MASHIACH EVENTS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CAMP LEADERSHIP TEAM.

ITEMS NOT TO BE USED AT CAMP:

- Cell phones*
- Smart Watches
- MP3/CD Players
- Roller Skates
- Skate Boards
- Tablets/Laptops/Kindles/iPads
- Headphones/AirPods/Earbuds

**All phones & smartwatches from Campers are collected at check in [items used as legitimate medical devices are excluded from this], and are stored in a locked facility during camp. These are given back at check out. Use of phones by campers is prohibited. If you need to contact your parents, or there is an emergency, talk to an adult staff member.*

The use of foul language will not be tolerated in any form or fashion. It will be the judgment of an adult staff member to determine what is inappropriate. Fighting or activity that has the intention of causing harm to another person will not be tolerated. Modesty will prevail in all clothing matters. Likewise, any questionable slogans, graphics, or any political or socially charged statements on clothing will not be allowed. It will be the judgment of an adult staff member to determine what is inappropriate. For your safety, closed-toed shoes are to be worn at all times. During co-ed swim activities, girls are to wear a dark shirt & shorts over all bathing suits, and guys are to wear a dark shirt with swim trunks. You will not be allowed to leave the camp facilities for any reason without the approval of the Camp Security. You must also follow further guidelines that will be announced on the first day of camp.

I understand and agree to follow the rules of Camp Mashiach and to conduct myself in a way that is moral and upright before the Lord. I will follow the camp schedule and participate in all activities to the best of my ability. I will respect all "off-limit" areas and honor each nightly curfew. I will not be alone with any member of the opposite sex at any time during Camp Mashiach. I understand that these five days are meant to be a departure from the secular world, and I will not say, wear, or do anything that may offend others. I will do my best to make new friends and be a blessing to everyone at camp. Above all, I will have fun and receive the blessing that Camp Mashiach has for me.
